Green Flag for Lodge Farm Park On Tuesday 14th September, the prestigious Green Flag was raised for a third year in Lodge Farm Park. This is a great accolade for the grounds maintenance team, working in both Raphael & Lodge Farm parks. The Green Flag Award Scheme was set up in 1996 to recognise and reward the best of Britains green spaces. Since 2009, the Green Flag Award scheme has been managed by a new consortium, comprising of Keep Britain Tidy, the British Trust for Conservation Volunteers (BTCV) and GreenSpace. Brief History of the Friends of Raphael & Lodge Farm Parks We formed in November 2004, primarily to take care of Raphael Park but within weeks we took on Lodge Farm Park too. We are a non-political, not-for-profit group made up of local residents. We work together with the council and police. Our goal is to improve, protect and provide a safe and fun Park for all to enjoy. Well enough about us, lets get on with the news.....

Heritage Lottery Stage 2 We are meeting regularly each month with the London Borough of Havering (LBH) and Chris Blandford Associates (CBA) who have been appointed by the LBH to develop an application to the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) for funding to restore and regenerate the park, CBA are one of Britians leading environmental planning and landscape consultants, working on restoration projects such as the Royal Botanic Gardens - Kew, Peckham Rye Park - London, Broadlands -Hampsire, Alexandra Park, - Sussex, Stonehenge and many world Heritage Sites. Our role is to provide user information and views on our needs in the park to ensure that the parks refurbishment meets the needs of the local community. To this end you will have recently received a questionnaire through your letterbox the response to which was overwhelming. Thank you all for your comments and your time. At this stage of the application it is imperative that we provide LBH & CBA as much information as possible. CBA's Design Team Leader hopes to attend our next meeting on 18th October. If you have any ideas to put forward or issues to raise please join us. You will need to fill in a question time request form: please ask for one when you arrive.

The Friends Sponsored Flower Beds We are very grateful to the LBH for their kind donation to of the geraniums, which were taken out of the main entrance flower beds last week. We have now cut back and potted almost 400 plants, our fingers are crossed that at least half of them will survive our novices approach to gardening. Fingers crossed for a blooming 2011.

**Bulb Planting** In September two of the Friends Group, Len and Don, planted 1,000 bluebells and 15kg of daffodils in the woods. Watch out for a colourful Spring, unless of course the squirrels are looking a lot fatter!

Blacks Brook Picnic Area Would you like a place to relax in the woods? It could be a great way to get closer to nature. Many of us already feed the squirrels and birds there. We would like to know what you think of a natural picnic area blending into the wood, providing log seating and picnic tables made from locally felled trees. Spring and summer bulb planting to enhance and ensure it will become beautifully fragrant.
